

All owner/exhibitors must be National Pinto members. PtHA membership card must be shown to be eligible for Open, Youth and Amateur Classes.

All Pinto's must be registered with PtHA and Proof of Registration will be required at the show. All current regular PtHA rules and fees apply.

YA Walk/Trot Classes are Pinto approved and follow PtHA rules/requirements and may not show in any other riding class that canters or any other Showmanship class. **Non-Pointed Walk/Trot Trail may not show in any other Trail Class. YA Leadline Classes are Indiana Pointed Only.**AM Walk/Trot Classes are Pinto approved and follow PtHA rules/requirements and may not show in any other riding class that canters, may show in halter and showmanship class.

No Refunds once show has started, unless class has less than 3 entries, the exhibitor may withdraw and receive a refund, if entered using the per class fee. No refunds using the economy fee, exhibitor may substitute a class for a scratched class. PtHA \$1 fee is not refundable.

Show Committee reserves the right to combine/cancel any class. All AM & YA classes with 5 or less entries will be combined. Entry into this show constitutes an agreement that IPtHA, Fulton County 4-H Equestrian Center and PtHA will not be held responsible for any loss, theft or injury occurring at this show.

All *out of state* Equine must have a current coggins (within 12 months) and Health Papers (within 30 days) in their possession, per Indiana State Law.


- **1.** You must be a current 2017 member of IPtHA at the time of nomination, no later than August 5, 2017. Points will count after nomination is received and dues are paid. Under no circumstances will points be made retroactive.
- **2.** Horse and /or Pony/Minatures must be registered in the Pinto Horse Association. All leased horses and/or pony/mini must be an IPtHA member.
- **3.** Only IPtHA approved shows will count toward IPtHA High Point Awards. IPtHA approval must come from the IPtHA President.
 - The shows approved for 2017 are: Spring Show at Rochester, May 6 & 7 (4 judges), EC Jubilee Show at New Castle, August 5 & 6, (3 judges, not average card) and Fall Hoosier Classic show at New Castle, September 9 & 10 (4 judges).
- **4.** Ties for awards will be broken by the horse/pony/mini or rider/driver with the most firsts, then seconds, then thirds, etc., then most classes shown.
- **5.** You must show under at least 7 different judges from the above IPtHA show list to qualify for an IPtHA Year End Award.
- **6.** Lead Line Classes will award points to the rider only. Walk/Trot and Leadline Classes: Exhibitors in these classes can-not show in any canter classes or the points in these classes will not count.
- **7.** Transferred horse will retain all accrued points to date of sale. Points do not transfer to the new owner.
- **8.** Any horse changing types will lose all previously acquired points. Altered stallions will retain their type halter points.
- **9.** NO extra points for Grand or Reserve Champion winners will be awarded.





I would like to thank everyone I have ever known through my journey in Pinto. I attended my 1st pinto show not as an exhibitor, but as a commercial exhibitor and sponsor in 1989. I arrived in Tulsa in a Rental truck full of saddles to be given away as awards, and set up a commercial booth. Pryor to attending that show I had been actively showing in AQHA, Arabian, Palomino with my Saddlebred, and my girls were both showing their POA and Pinto ponies. By the time I left that show I had found a new Home. Joe Grissom who was Executive Vice President of the association, and Wyneta Duncan who was Youth Director made me realize that this was not just a Breed Association but a Family. It was amazing how many times our paths had crossed, yet we did not know each other. Here was an organization that we could show all types, and go to only ONE show. It was awesome, and made for our show interests.

We went back to Indiana, bought four paint mares, registered my two Arabian Stallions as outcross stallions with Pinto and we were in the Pinto breeding program. We joined Indiana Pinto, became active as an officer, served as Secretary and Vice President, and 18 years ago I became your Sector Director, when Joe Grissom asked me to finish John Young's term when he was tragically killed. I have held that position ever since. Over the years we showed Indiana Shows, Michigan, Ohio and Many National and World shows. There were times we arrived at a show with a Stock Type Mare, Zippo Kats or Sheza Bonanza, Saddle Type Gelding Moonlight Prophacy, Pleasure Type Gelding TM Color Coded, Pleasure Type Pony Oreo Masterpiece, and the very 1st Mini to show Indiana Snicker Doodles. I tried to convince my husband that as Sector Director I could not discriminate. I don't think he bought it, but put his foot down when we added Gypsy Vanners!! We would show in as many as 28 classes at one show. I have had a wonderful experience to share with my daughter and granddaughter through the Pinto Horse.

We had been taking award saddles to the world show and hauling horses to show as well as our commercial booth, I must have been crazy. It was truly a labor of love. When we stopped donating the saddles to the world show, and hauling our horses there to show I could not stop going I had not missed one since 1989, so I continued to go as Wyneta's helper with the Youth events at the show. When Daryl asked me to be on the show staff I jumped at the chance, and for the past several years I have been at the ID Station Inspecting horses coming to show. I have not missed a World show since 1989, and I now consider it my Pinto Family Reunion. Wyneta and I are both on the Show Staff working the ID Station and we literally get to see everyone who attends the show.

Now that I have reached an age where showing is not an option, all my show horses got old, I enjoy announcing our Pinto shows.

Never in my wildest dreams could I imagine 28 years ago when I attended that 1st Pinto National Show that I would be inducted into the Pinto Hall of Fame. What an honor for me. This is because all of you, a friendship and family atmosphere of this organization is why I wanted to be active and continue to be. Those of you who were responsible for this nomination have given me the greatest honor of my life. Thank You

2017 PtHA Convention

March 1-4, Wyndham Garden, Oklahoma City, OK

What a great year, this was one of the best attended conventions we have had in a long time. Roger Altman welcomed us all to the convention with "GO THE DISTANCE" as his mantra for us. The great thing about our association and its convention is that members can attend, and sit on a committee of their choice. Those attending the various committee meetings were not only responsible for voting on rule change proposals, but having discussions and suggestions to be presented to the Executive Board on ideas and directions for Pinto to go over the next few years. This gives our members a chance to be a part of rule changes and putting forward ideas on what you want the Pinto Horse Association to become. You are GOING THE DISTANCE for your association. Members on a committee can vote on any proposals that are put before the board. If they vote it down it goes no further. If they pass the rule proposal forward, it goes on to the breed council which is made up of all chair and co-chairs of the all committees. This gives all committees a chance to voice opinions on new changes, and a vote is held to either table, or defeat, or pass the bill on to the board of directors. The Board of Directors is made up of the Sector Directors that each state elects to represent them on the board. The rule change proposals are brought before the board and they are either passed and become a rule change or defeated.

As your Sector Director I was so proud of our charter this year at the convention, we had a large member turnout, I wouldn't be surprised if we did not have the largest state group. It was truly an honor to represent such an active group, and the icing on top of the cake for our state was wining the Superior Charter Award. A big thank you to Cheryl Ann Walls for all the work she did in submitting our charter for this award. I am not 100% sure but I think there was 8 or 9 charters that submitted for this award. Good Job Indiana – That's what I call going the distance.

Of the 9 committees that were held during the convention Joe Grissom Chairs the Long-Range Planning Committee, and sets on the Registration Committee. Wyneta Duncan Chairs the Youth Committee, and Becki Meek and Levi Evans sit on that committee. I am Co-Chair of the Membership/Marketing Committee. Darren Evans and Bobbieann Lawrence sat on the Show and Contest Committee, Bobbieann is also on the Heritage Foundation Board of which Joe Grissom is the President. Other Indiana members attending were Jim Yagel, Jill Duzan and Jamie Garriott. And a big thank you to Richard Evans for coming and supporting Levi and Darren. A very big thank you to my daughters Tanya Franklin and Marnie Curl for coming to support me for the Hall of Fame Induction.

Just a note to all our members, this is your chance to have a say in the running of your breed association. By attending the convention, you can be appointed to any committee that you are interested in. Rule changes that are proposed go before the committee it pertains to, and you the member have a say in whether it becomes a rule change or it is defeated. This is a very important part of being a member of the association, I would love to see more of you taking the opportunity to be a part of your organization.

This year we had only a few rule change proposals, one was for Show and Contest both amateur and youth. It was proposed to make the walk trot divisions points count toward ROM points and advanced awards. These were defeated due to verbiage of advanced awards, it was argued that would create a nightmare for pointing toward superior championships etc. It was also felt that in the youth 11 & Under division, it would point those kids out of the Novice division before they reach the ability to walk trot and canter. Those that wanted the rule change are wanting to earn points and recognition in a class

division that they felt they would never leave. These members felt they would never show anything but walk trot as they had reached an age where they no longer felt comfortable to canter, or due to physical limitations could not canter. The argument was that this created a place for very competitive members to earn points toward the more coveted advanced awards, and that would defeat the purpose of the rule change. Change the verbiage and bring the bill back, as it is recognized that there is a group here that would benefit and enjoy ROM and ROE awards.

A rule change for not allowing tail knots below the tail muscle. This was defeated in committee, so I did not hear the arguments for or against this rule proposal.

The most important rule change to come before the board of directors was presented by the executive committee concerning registration. Our rules currently allow any APHA registered horse with Color papers to automatically qualify for Pinto papers. The APHA has decided that they are a breed, and will now register all horses based on DNA rather than visual appearance. This will put solid horses showing with colored horses, I am not sure this was a good thing for the Appaloosa when they did it. But Pinto has decided that we are a "color breed". For that reason, we will no longer automatically accept APHA based on their papers only, they must meet the color requirement previously set for their registry.

Of importance is that 2 new ranch horse classes have been added, they are Ranch Trail, and Ranch Rail Pleasure. In the past, you could not cross enter between the divisions. To help this division to grow this year you can cross enter the classes, but you must follow the ranch horse rules such as no hoof black, braiding, banding or false tails. They have added 9 new mini classes to the world show in the solid division.

Due to lack of participation at the world show in the Zone Invitational's, they are now inviting the top 4 instead of the top 2 in each division. As the awards for this is quite extensive at the world show it would be nice if we have more competition in these classes.

It should be noted that Pinto has successfully registered all our trademarks, such as the 4 heads each charter will receive a guide as to the use of these trademarks. The use of these trademarks outside of official Pinto business will be strictly enforced.

Long-Range planning suggested that there be no fee changes for 2018 other than Youth Novice and Youth Amateur, and that will rise to \$15.

The office will begin charging a NSF on credit card declines. They will use discretion in this as it is meant mostly for those that come into the office for show entries, registrations, etc.

The Utility division has been expanded. We will now recognize and register all draft horse and draft crosses with pinto characteristics. We will have the Gypsy, and the Drum/Draft.

Thank you so much for allowing me to represent this organization as your sector director. It is truly an honor to hold this position, and one I take very seriously.

Health Care for the Older Horse: Not so Geriatric Anymore!

Geriatrics: a branch of veterinary medicine that deals with the problems and diseases of the aged veterinary patient. The productive life of a horse has increased to a point that we need to start taking into account the changes that take place as they age. At one time the productive or serviceable life of a horse was considered to be 8-12 years of age. This does not hold true anymore. With the advancements of veterinary medicine we can easily extend this into late teens and even into the 20's. Horses are easily living to see 30 years of age and beyond. At a conference this fall for equine veterinarians the room was polled to see who was treating the oldest horse and multiple veterinarians had horses in their 40's. The oldest horse was 52 years of age.

The reasons for longer productive life and life-span include:

- 1. New and improved medical knowledge and treatments
- 2. Better dental care
- 3. Improved deworming protocols
- 4. Early detection of disease
- 5. Better nutrition



With the advancement of geriatric veterinary medicine we now have the capability to identify and rectify medical conditions that only affect the aged horse allowing us to keep them productive for significantly more years. In order to treat these changes we have to be able to identify them. The physical appearance of the horse can help us identify some of these medical conditions, but blood work advances allow us to identify some of these conditions

before they become physically evident. Some of the changes that we can see include:



- Swaying of back
- Unthrifty, rough, dull hair coat
- Slow to shed hair coat
- Poor condition, pot belly
- Lack of muscle tone
- Fat deposits along tail head, prepuce, and neck
- Lack of joint flexibility
- Incisor teeth elongation
- Graying of hair
- Reduced feed utilization
- Lameness
- Hoof abnormalities
- Tendon laxity



Some of the earliest signs of aging are unsoundness and difficulty moving. One of the most common owner observed problems of the aging horse is arthritis. As veterinarians we are trained to look for the more subtle signs that lead us to diagnose the problem before it becomes more clinically apparent.

The Conley & Koontz Equine Hospital recommends our Geriatric Wellness Program as a preventative measure for early detection and implementation of medical management for the changes your horse is going through physically and physiologically. This program was established as an aid for you and your veterinarian to detect and establish baseline values for some of the most common problems affecting the aged horse. Appropriate medical intervention will allow your horse to live a long and healthy life.

The Geriatric Wellness Program includes:

- 1. Complete Physical Examination and Oral Examination
- 2. Lameness evaluation
- 3. Complete Blood Count and Chemistry Profile
- 4. Blood Insulin, Glucose, and ACTH
- 5. Patient Specific Medical Plan:
- a. Vaccination
- b. Deworming
- c. Dental
- d. Medical Therapy
- e. Nutritional consultation

Based on the initial findings of the physical and oral examination, as well as blood results, our veterinarians will report to you personally any of their findings and recommendations. Some of the findings may direct the veterinarian to perform additional tests and diagnostics for the treatment of your aged horse. These reports and findings serve as a baseline for your horse's health which will direct us for many years to come.

We highly recommend our Geriatric Wellness Program for all horses over 15 years of age.

WEST NILE VIRUS

West Nile Virus (WNV) is a virus transmitted by mosquitoes. Birds are the main reservoir for the virus, but humans and horses can contract the disease if bitten by an infected mosquito. Horses and humans do not produce high levels of the virus, so the virus is not transmissible from casual horse to horse contact or horse to human contact.

The majority of infected horses show little to no clinical signs of the disease. The most common signs are fever, depression, and poor appetite. Only a small percentage of infected horses will develop neurological symptoms characteristic of the disease. Neurological signs of the disease include ataxia (uncoordinated movement when walking), head pressing, paralysis, and behavioral changes such as depression or hyperexcitability to stimuli. The tongue and facial muscles can be affected, so they may have difficulty eating or easy choke on food. Fatality is 30-40% in horses with clinical signs and much higher in horses with severe symptoms such as recumbency.

There is no specific treatment for West Nile Virus, so treatment usually involves supportive care and anti-inflammatories to decrease swelling and inflammation in the brain and spinal cord. If your horse begins to show any neurological signs, be sure to call your veterinarian to have your horse examined. Most horses that survive recover completely in a few weeks to months. Blood samples can be drawn and tested for antibodies to WNV to confirm infection.

The most important way to prevent West Nile Virus is to vaccinate your horse. We recommend that adult horses should be vaccinated every 6 months. Pregnant mares be vaccinated one month before their due date, thereby transferring protection to their foals. Foals should be vaccinated at 5 months and boostered at 6 months. Foals from dams that did not get pre-foaling vaccines may receive their initial vaccine as early as 3 months of age with boosters 1 month later. If you acquire a horse that has not had any prior vaccines, or are uncertain of the vaccination history, the initial vaccines should be boostered one month later.

It is also important to limit exposure to mosquitoes and remove any stagnant water sources that act as mosquito breeding areas. West Nile Virus can be a devastating disease that is preventable, so be sure to booster your horse if he has not been vaccinated recently!

At Conley and Koontz Equine Hospital we include the WNV vaccine in our annual vaccine package as well as our semi-annual booster recomendations. HOOF PUNCTURE CASE STUDY

Case Presentation: "Jiff" a 9 year old gelding presented with a few day history of drainage from the bottom of the foot and a severe lameness. His owner had been treating the foot for a suspected sole abscess for a few days prior to presentation.

Physical Examination: On presentation he had a grade 4/5 lameness in the left front limb. There was minimal swelling of the limb. On examination of the bottom of the foot there was what appeared to be granulation tissue near the apex of the frog. The granulation tissue bed was probed and found to be fairly large and undermining the frog.

Diagnostics: Due to the severity and duration of the lameness, radiographs were taken to evaluate the bony structures within the hoof capsule. Standard radiographs were taken (Figure 1). There was no apparent bony involvement on plain radiographs. A sterile instrument was used to probe the extent of the granulation tissue (Figure 2). Based on radiographs it was apparent that the wound was more than likely a puncture wound and that it had a tract that extended to the navicular bone.



Plan: Based on the size, location, and extent of the wound a "Street Nail" or navicular bursotomy was scheduled. The horse would be placed under general anesthesia and the wound would be debrided and lavaged. While under anesthesia the coffin joint would be aspirated to rule out communication with the wound. The navicular bone and bursa are close anatomically with the coffin joint, and wounds in this area frequently communicate. Intravenous regional limb perfusion would also be performed.

Surgery: The limb was positioned to allow us access to the bottom of the foot. The limb was clipped, prepped and draped. Intravenous regional limb perfusion with antibiotics was administered prior to starting the surgical procedure. Prior to debriding the puncture wound, a sample of synovial fluid from the coffin joint was taken to determine joint involvement. The fluid was found to be abnormal with a white cell count of >80,000. Anything over 20,000 is deemed infected. Due to the high white cell count the joint was pressurized with sterile saline to see if the joint directly communicated with the puncture wound. At the time

of surgery it did not appear that the coffin joint was readily communicating with the wound. Multiple needles were used to sterilely flush the coffin joint and administer intra-articular antibiotics (Figure 3).

The puncture wound was debrided and found to directly communicate with the navicular bone and therefore navicular bursa (Figure 4). The necrotic tissue was all removed down to healthy, normal tissue. After debriding the wound we realized the damaged area resembled a hole that a T-post would make (Figure 5). The wound was packed with sterile gauze and the foot was bandaged.

Postoperative: His recovery was uneventful. He almost immediately walked better after surgery. He received daily antibiotics and anti-inflammatories. For the initial 4 days postoperatively, he was walked to the stocks and the bandage was removed. The coffin joint was flushed and intra-articular antibiotics were administered. In addition, intravenous regional perfusion with antibiotics was performed daily. The white cell count within the coffin joint remained normal after this time. The wound was bandaged daily until the drainage became minimal.

After having a discussion with the owner that this was most likely a puncture wound that appeared to be in the shape of a T-post, I challenged the owner to find an old fence line where T-posts could have been removed improperly. The owner obtained some historical satellite images of his farm and found an old fence line that was no longer present. When walking the old fence line, the owner came upon multiple broken off T-posts in a waterbed where only a small amount of the post was visible. He actually found the T-post that his horse had stepped on (Figure 6, 7).

After a decent granulation bed had formed and the drainage had decreased, he was placed into a patent bar shoe with a full hospital plate (Figure 8, 9). He remained on antibiotics and stall rest at our hospital for the first 45 days after surgery. After this time he was discharged to his owners for stall rest. Over the next few months, the patent bar shoe elevation was decreased. His amount of turnout in a small paddock was also increased. At the time of this case report, the owners and the farrier had reported that he was sound at the walk (Figure 10).

Discussion: Although puncture wounds of the sole can appear small, they are often deep and can have disastrous consequences. When dealing with puncture wounds to the foot, time is of the essence. There are many important structures within the hoof capsule and they only are protected by millimeters of hoof capsule and sole. Anytime you suspect a puncture wound you should call your veterinarian immediately. If you find your horse with the penetrating object still in the hoof, you should leave it until your veterinarian arrives to visually and radiographically inspect it. Puncture wounds of the frog and sole are readily missed. The entry site tends to cover up as the object comes out. If the penetrating object remains in place, the horse will usually be lame immediately. Some horses may remain comfortable if the object comes out until infection sets in. With the object left in place, radiographs can allow you to determine the extent of the penetrating object. If there is no object in place, an instrument, probe, or contrast agent can be passed in the tract to determine the extent of the tract. Depending on the location and depth of the puncture wound various structures can be affected. If you suspect your horse to have a puncture wound, we encourage you to call us immediately at Conley and Koontz Equine Hospital.





- (C) Participation and cooperation
- (D) Neatness of youth and mount while in the show ring


