

2. Horse and/or Pony/Miniatures must be registered in the Pinto Horse Association. All leased horses and/or pony/mini must have a copy of the lease on file with the High Point Chairman. The person leasing the horse/pony/mini must be an IPtHA member.
3. Only IPtHA approved shows will count toward IPtHA High Point Awards. IPtHA approval must come from the IPtHA President.
The shows approved for 2016 are: **Spring Show at Rochester, May 14-15 (4 judges), EC Jubilee Show at New Castle, August 6-7, (3 judges, not average card) and Fall Hoosier Classic show at New Castle, September 10-11 (4 judges).**
4. Ties for awards will be broken by the horse/pony/mini or rider/driver with the most firsts, then seconds, then thirds, etc., then most classes shown.
5. You must show under at least 7 different judges from the above IPtHA show list to qualify for an IPtHA Year End Award.
6. Walk/Trot and Lead Line classes will award points to the rider only. Children/Adults riding in these classes can-not show in any canter classes or the points in these classes will not count.

2016 Pinto Horse Convention report

As usual the convention this year was very enjoyable. It was great to have such a good Indiana turnout. Joe and Barbara Grissom, BA and Jim, Darren and Levi, Wyneta and Becky and myself did a great job representing Indiana. For those who have not attended you really need to go and see how this organization works for you.

As your Sector Director 17 I attended the Board of Director Meeting along with directors from 24 states and 2 providences of Canada, and this year we sat our first International Sector Director from Sweden. The purpose of this meeting was to bring everyone up to date on the association over the last year. I have my program if anyone wants to look at it as it has charts and information concerning financials and budgets. Like all organizations we were down last year in the membership by 3%, youth unfortunately was down by 7%. Luckily we are not down as much as other associations over the past year. PtHA approved 112 shows in 2015, up slightly over 2014 and there were a total of 123105 entries judged, with 2380 horses which was down only 1% from 2411 in 2014. So our membership is still supporting our shows and we are still doing quiet well as an organization.

During our board of directors meeting all of the Departments gave reports on what is being done in their departments. The most significant change has been to the IT department. This year it was decided that PtHA will do their own web casting so it can be better controlled and affordable. Being everything is now handled in house we can do much more and be in control of what is done. We had the convention on live feed, and hopefully many of you at home were able to watch the awards ceremony and general membership meeting. Watch for the world show as this will be on live feed as well. Joe Grissom is chair of the Long Range Planning Committee and during his report he mentioned that they are setting up a 3 year calendar for upcoming shows so that states can work together in setting non conflicting dates for our shows. One of the things they are addressing is the 250 mile range in approving shows so that shows on the same weekend are not close enough to hurt the shows.

The Heritage committee announced a new program called AmazonSmile. Those of you who use Amazon may know they are offering a program which is no cost to the user, but they will give 0.5% of your purchase to a charity of your choice. Pinto Heritage Scholarship Fund is now listed in that program. When you visit smile.amazon.com you merely select Pinto Heritage Foundation as your charitable organization to receive donations. That information will be remembered and every time you shop Amazon every eligible purchase will be result in a donation to the Pinto Heritage Fund.

The IT department also has an Equine Internet Sell page for our members to sell their horses. You can go to Pinto.org to find out information if you have items to sell. It was discussed that social media is a great benefit, and those who use it should strive to constantly make changes and post new information to keep people coming and sharing their horse interests.

The Board recessed our meeting so that all the committees could meet to consider the rule change proposals as well as discuss things that they felt would be of importance to report back to the Association. There were 22 rules up for consideration. Any one attending the convention can ask to sit on a committee when they send in their registrations. Members are not sat on committees once the convention starts. By being on a committee it gives our members a chance to have their voices heard.

Committees meet and not all of them have rule changes to discuss but their chairs and vice chairs ask for suggestions on what the members would like to see addressed. If you committee has a rule change that is pertinent to that committee it would be discussed and voted upon. If you vote it down it is dead and goes no further. If you pass it on to the breed council it goes on. Breed Council is made up of all the Chairmen and Vice-Chairs of all the committees. Indiana people who sit on the council are Wyneta who represents Youth, Joe Grissom who represents Long Range Planning, and my self as Vice Chair of Membership/Charters and Marketing. The proposals are again discussed and are either defeated, or passed on to the board of directors. When the board of directors reconvene the rules that have not been defeated are voted on and finally they will be changed in the rule book.

During the Membership, Marketing committee meeting we discussed the problem of falling registrations and what we can do to help. Shawna from the office said that the National office is offering a free Zone ad for each charter after they renew. Some members would like to see some special discounts given to encourage registrations; we now give a special price to 4-H members. In general it was felt that we need to do more to promote some of the other programs such as on the trail, and occap as that could bring in more members to our clubs that might not be interested in showing. Also we need to work on getting more solid horses into the show ring letting them know how easy it is to register their horse and come and show with us. I am sure that all the other committees had very good working meetings as well.

It is nice to have our member's active and taking part. During the convention there are seminars for Field Reps, Show managers, and Charter president's breakfast. I encourage as many members as possible to attend a convention at least once, just going and seeing the National Headquarters is well worth the trip.

Levi Evans was signed up as our Youth Director and will be attending the World Show Youth meeting in June. I look forward to being at the shows and hope that our Indiana members that are coming to the shows enjoy it just as much.



Let Me Introduce Myself

My name is Cheryl Ann Walls, but a lot of people recognize my former married name of Kratzert as I showed for many years under that. I'm married to a wonderful, understanding man, Mark Walls that works as a Senior Engineer for AEP. I have two grown girls, both living in FL and soon to be 4 grandchildren. I was raised on a hog and cattle farm in Marion, IN we had any sort of a number of animals, from the above mentioned to chickens, geese and exotics (which I obtained from my "uncle") who worked as the caretaker of our local zoo, foxes, peacocks, all sorts of fowl, mountain goats and even a baby lion for awhile. It taught me to get up early and go to bed late, nothing ever was left unfed, without clean water or in a dirty stall. I guess you could say it taught me responsibility.

My love of horses came from two very influential people in my life, my Mother, and my Great Uncle Pat. Mom started me on her horse, an Appaloosa at barely 3 yrs old. My Uncle Pat would sneak me out of school on Thursdays to head to a horse auction in Rushville. These two incredible influences guided me in several directions. Uncle Pat loved the pulling ponies and I had a wonderful matched PINTO team at a very early age. My Mother was more of a trail rider and her Appaloosa, Duke afforded me those miles to learn and understand what makes a horse "tick".

As a teenager I was then introduced to contesting...yep a real "can chaser". So Quarter Horses became the horse for me and contesting was the way to go, poles, barrels, down and backs, any speed event was just up my alley. Into my young adult life I had the fortune or misfortune to become involved on the Standardbred circuit, driving Pacers and Trotters. I can only say it was an eye opening adventure but did accelerate my love of driving. Moving on in life I found myself at the University of Georgia, working, taking some classes, and married. But I needed my horse fix so I went to work part time on a Walking Horse Farm, on the side I rode anything any one would bring my way. I noticed the inhumane treatment of this breed and vowed never to become one of those that needed to use mechanical or physical abuse to teach any animal. My next endeavor brought me into the cutting horse field. It was exciting and stimulating, but also a discipline that would take a lot of money and a very well trained animal, which I learned early on that I had no knack for training. At this time I found myself with my first small farm in Roanoke and introduced to a beautiful breed of horses, the Arabian; a majestic horse with a floating trot, big eye, a master piece of art from the hooves up. My daughters and I showed in halter, showmanship, western, English, and Brea did Equitation. It took us to the Nationals on many occasions with a tremendous outcome. When Mark and I married, he announced although he loved my small herd he did fancy a "colored" horse, like that of "Little Joe's " on Bonanza, OK I'm dating myself again. On the hunt for a black and white, that in my eye had to be at least half-Arabian. When I found our girl, Magical Miss, the road to the world of Pintos began to spring open. We bred her to our Arabian Stallion, Lea Grandee and got our first Pinto Half-Arabian foal, a filly FWF C N Spotz that went on to win five National Championships, and many top awards, I own this mare to this day. Next I thought well if I want English or big trotting animals I have to have a Saddlebred to cross on my mares, but a Pinto of course, and in came Becky Strange with Colour Me Hot, who by the way produced the top earning Saddlebred stallion that EVERY Arabian owner wanted to breed to, The Color of Fame. What of my Western horses, another breed to introduce,

the Paint horse, and along came Doc's Double Dealin. Over the years I bred, trained and showed any number of crosses from these two, but as time passes, age takes over. It became apparent that I could no longer keep 25-30 head. The girls had too grown up, going off to college, law school, and soon finding careers, getting married and moving to the South. I had to downsize. My love of horses would only bring me to yet another breed which happily I must say has once again enhanced my world....the Miniature. First a small PINTO of course stallion named Manes and Tails Blackie or lovingly "Mini Me", various mares, geldings and foals have been in the barn, that have all taught me one thing. The love of the horse for me is all about the conformation, personality and those wonderful PINTO markings. I have been privileged to become involved in a group that has allowed me to not only be a person that enters the ring, but I have become a member of the Indiana Pinto Horse Assoc. sitting on the Board of Directors, as well as being a Past President. It's about the friendship, rather than the showing now, I feel like I've done most of what I've wanted to achieve. I continue to show my little miniatures in most every aspect of classes offered, halter, color, showmanship, trail, driving, hunter, jumper you name it we've tried it. So who I am, is a person that loves all breeds, have run the gambit on most disciplines, and ended up just where I belonged...happy in knowing all have their places...but there's NOTHING LIKE A PINTO!





ARE YOU AND YOUR TRAILER READY TO TRAVEL??


When you are on the road with your trailer, you not only have the responsibility of keeping your horse safe, you also have the responsibility to yourself, whoever is riding with you, and to all the other drivers out there on the road. You certainly don't want to be responsible for causing an accident that may result in injury or death to your horse or someone else. By making

the right choices, you can maximize your safety and minimize your chances of an accident. Here are a few reminders on trailer safety:

- Make sure the ball on the tow vehicle is the correct size for the trailer!
- Check over your hitch, coupler, breakaway brake battery, and safety chains. Make sure all are hooked up and latched properly. Make sure all lights and the brakes are working properly before you load the horses.
- Check tire pressure in the tires on the tow vehicle and the trailer. Improper tire pressure is one of the most common reasons for trailer sway. A suggestion is to have your tires filled with nitrogen instead of just air. This will help prevent expansion as the tire warms up.
- Check tire condition, especially if the trailer has been sitting for a while. Make sure you have the correct tire iron to change the tire. The spare tire nut may be a different size than the actual wheels so double check you have all sizes necessary.
- Check lug nuts on the wheels. Wheel nuts and bolts should be tightened before first road use on a trailer and after each wheel removal. Check often!
- Check the inside of the trailer for bees and wasp nests.
- When the horses are loaded make sure all doors are latched properly, and horses are tied.
- Drive down the driveway and before you drive onto the road, get out and check your hitch assembly again. Take a look at the horses too, to make sure they're good to go.
- If you happen to stop somewhere where the rig has been left unattended, check everything all over again. Someone may have been tampering with the trailer or the horses.

QUICK REFERENCE

SAFTEY POINT	WHAT TO DO
TIRES	Check pressure, and look for signs of wear in truck, trailer, and spare tires
WHEELS	Make sure lug nuts are tight on all wheels
HITCH	Look for loose bolts, hairline cracks, and other signs of wear. Check for proper hookup. (In conventional trailers, the socket should be seated on the ball and locked in place.)
SAFETY CHAINS	Make sure chains are crossed and hooked to vehicle frame (not bumper).
BREAKAWAY	Check cable length. It should be shorter than your safety chains, but not so short that it'll break free when you make a tight brake cable turn. Weave the cable through a link of one chain, so it won't snag and pull free. Make sure coupler is fully plugged in.
TRUCK	Check fluid levels and fill fuel tanks



If you are in 4-H, you can register your horse as pinto for a 50% discounted rate. You must have/show proof of 4-H membership.

How can my horse be registered as a pinto you ask??
That's easy!! Your horse, pony or miniature have to meet the color requirements. A horse must have 4 inches total of eligible white in qualifying zones, whereas a pony must have 3 inches and a miniature must have 2 inches total. Even solid colored horses can be registered in the Solid Division.





INDIANA PINTO MEMORIAL YOUTH AWARD RULES

1. Youth must not have passed his/her 18th birthday on January 1 of current year.
2. Youth must show a registered Pinto owned or leased by either the youth or his/her family. Family ownership is to be used as it is by the Pinto Horse Association of America.
3. Youth must be a member in good standing with the Indiana Pinto Horse Association.
4. Youth must be a member in good standing with the Pinto Horse Association of America.
5. Youth must not be married or ever have been married.
6. Points will be earned at Indiana Pinto shows.
7. Points will count on a one horse, one rider combination.
8. Points will be calculated using the same method as the Indiana Pinto Horse Association uses for their high point awards system,
9. The deadline for counting points will be the same beginning and ending dates as designated annually by the Indiana Pinto Horse Association for their high point awards.
10. Youth may compete annually for this award as long as she/he meets all the requirements regardless of the number of times the youth has won the award.

- (B) Sportsmanship
- (C) Participation and cooperation

Zone Shows to Area Championship Shows; International Championship Shows to Pinto World Championship Shows; color registration to solid registration, the Pinto Horse Association of America has changed and grown tremendously throughout the past 60 years.

This year, the Pinto Horse Association of America is celebrating its 60th birthday!

The PtHA started from a grassroots movement to selectively breed horses for good color and conformation. Several horsemen in the 1930s formed the Pinto Horse Society with the purpose of breeding superior colored horses.

The registry they created shifted to the PtHA, which was formed in 1956 by Kay Heikens, Helen Hammond and other Pinto supporters.

The association started in New Jersey and relocated to several other locations including: Connecticut, Tulsa, Okla.; San Diego and Fort Worth, Texas. In 2004, PtHA moved to its present location, Bethany, Okla., because of the need for more office space, Joe Grissom, past Chief Operating Officer and Vice President, said.

Changes from office to office also brought changes to the PtHA staff and how the association operated.

"For many years, the association was run from the President's house," Grissom said. "Now, PtHA has progressed into a multi-million dollar corporation with a paid Chief Operating Officer and a large office staff owning its own building."

In the earlier years, the main focus of the association was registration and show approval for record keeping. Membership was not even required in order to participate in PtHA events.

Darrell Bilke, PtHA Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, initiated the idea of requiring a person to have a membership in order to participate in any PtHA event, Gerald Milburn, past PtHA President, said.

Today, the association has several membership opportunities including: individual, joint, corporate, youth and lifetime, just to name a few.

As the association changed in location and the way it runs, local charter shows became more consistent.

"[In the past,] shows and other national functions were operated by charters and volunteer workers," Milburn said. "Today, the association has strength with full time staff to enforce rules."

Now, with more than 30 charters throughout the United States, Canada and Sweden, PtHA members have local opportunities to get together and participate in local activities such as youth clubs, showing, and recreational riding to pro-

mote and encourage others to be involved with PtHA.

In 1975, the association developed a youth program, now known as The Pinto Youth Horse Association, to encourage the interest of the Pinto horse on a state and national level. Today, the program elects national officers each year during the Pinto World Championships.

"Listening and responding to our members has brought effective results to our growth," Milburn said. "You can't do everything that is suggested but at least you can listen with integrity."

Along with the many perks of being a PtHA member, the association would hold annual membership and Board of Directors meetings at National shows. This later developed into what is now known as the PtHA Annual Convention.

In the late 80's the association started holding a convention two times a year then eventually changed to holding an annual convention starting in the early 2000s.

Today, the PtHA convention's purpose is to award members for their outstanding achievements by giving out awards and scholarships. Awards PtHA gives out include: Pinto of the Year, Advanced Awards, Zone Rivalry, Zone Invitations, Youth and Amateur High Point, Saddle Race and scholarships to our youth members. The PtHA Convention also holds

many meetings to discuss improvements that can be made to the association.

With all the changes made throughout the years, the addition of the Solid Division registry has brought amazing results to the amount of horses in the show ring.

PtHA registration policies have made significant upgrades allowing more consistent growth and participation, Milburn said. For instance, in 1970, a horse had to have 150 square inches of white in order to be considered for the color registry. This eliminated about 75% of the Overo horses and 40% of the Tobiano horses.

Each year brings something new and exciting to the association. Throughout the decades the growth has been astonishing and promises to grow for years to come.

Today, the PtHA office is located in Bethany, Okla., and keeps track of nearly 150,000 registered Pintos and 47,000 PtHA members.



To My Surprise....There "Ain't No Baby"

Now those that may know of me, can attest to the fact that I have been in or around horses all of my life (or at least up till now). I've learned a number of things and desperately try to use that knowledge where and when I can. But, of course, with that said; I also am smart enough to rely on veterinarians when needed and have no qualms about involving them in any aspect of my horse care. Which of course is how I ended up with this tale of "there ain't no baby"! Over the years and I do mean a number of them, I have been breeding on and off. I started with Pulling Ponies, a cross of Welsh and Haflinger, then on to Appaloosas, Arabians, Half Arabians, NSH's, Saddlebreds, Paints, and finally Miniatures. Each foal was a well thought out inspiration, first in my head, then pedigrees compared long into the night, and finally the breeding. I kept very close records of just such, anticipating every new arrival with early enthusiasm. What color would it be? How would I choose the perfect "show name"? Would there be the much sought after "Pinto" markings? What would it be...filly or colt? In that regard I can say, I never cared, always just wanting Momma and Baby to be healthy. So when the time came to breed my first miniature you can only imagine my eagerness as the months drifted by. But her due date (according to my finely detailed records) came and went... nothing. As a responsible owner I decided to call the vet. Upon her arrival I explained, as

she already was well aware of, the detailed files meaning this mare should be having a foal any day...no milk, no loose tail, nothing to indicate she was even close. Only choice as a precaution, we decided to palp her...the results, NEGATIVE, there "ain't no baby". How could that be, she had been exposed many times, on different days, nights, weekends, you name it, and she didn't show any signs of coming back in to estrus. I was to say, at the very least, confused. I had waited many months for the first little foal, and now she was telling me there was nothing. Warily I walked back to the house to ponder my next move. Another month went by, plus a few weeks, still no sign of the mare in season. Something is wrong I told myself, trust your instinct, but alas time to call the vet again. However, this time she arrived with her ultra sound machine, one more exam, but again same resounding words, there "ain't no foal". A head scratcher at the very least, more tests would be necessary. I said, "Let's just wait till breeding season again", as by now it was late in the year. My heart was aching to see a mini foal at the farm, but it was not to be, so life continued on. Then one early morning, cold, dreary as it usually is in early February in Indiana I did my morning chores. It was bitter in the barn, but more so in the arena stalls...so "critters" often came inside for warmth or to just get away from the elements. I did the normal inside work, intending to feed the arena horses last. When suddenly I noticed movement in the miniature mare's stall, oh no did a dog get in there? Is the mare being attacked, why weren't my eyes focusing...my heart was pounding so hard I could hear it. The normal longer distance seemed to be just one giant leap. There in the stall, something moving, she's trying to hide it, but what....OMG it's a FOAL..... Nothing could hold me back. I scooped the little one up in my arms, Momma in hot pursuit and right into the main barn. Towels, a heater, everything I could think of to warm it up. Next call...Mark, my ever patient husband at work. Come home right away, the miniature mare had a foal it's wet, cold, and needs to be warmed up, I need your help. I must admit, he's use to those sorts or panic calls and always responds more effectively than I do. Yep, there he was, perfect in every way...Bright eyes, and that beautiful carmel coloring, indicating it was a buckskin, and yes those definite PINTO markings. Thrilled just doesn't do the event justice...overjoyed is more like it. But why did everyone keep saying there just "ain't no foal". How could we have all missed it? Days later, and after all the excitement, I went back to my records...turns out, my breeding days were just fine. Was it just a freak of nature, a mare that carries way over, no not that far off. As the mystery unfolded I learned one IMPORTANT left out date or should I say dates...While I was gone at a show, a friend decided to help me out by feeding for me. You guessed it, he just put all the minis out together. Of course they neglected to tell me this, so I was off almost three months. The ultra sound, well the foal was so big at the time, it was over the pelvis of the mare, and couldn't be indicated. Have I learned to trust my instinct? Yes, do I go just by breeding dates now, no way...but I could not have asked for a better outcome. What a surprise...and there WAS A FOAL.



Requirements

1. Participants must be current PtHA members and must maintain membership for the entire time in which hours are recorded toward a recognition level. Membership forms are available at www.pinto.org or by calling (405) 491-0111.
2. Pintos must be permanently registered before accumulating hours. Participants do not have to own or lease the Pinto they use in this program.
3. An enrollment application and a one-time enrollment fee of \$35 per Pinto and rider/driver combination must be submitted prior to recording hours.
4. No substitutions of Pintos or riders/drivers allowed.

Logging Hours

1. Time may be recorded for any non-competitive activity in which a member participates by riding or driving. (i.e. drill team practice, therapeutic riding, trail riding, riding or driving in a group, parade, clinic, schooling session, lesson, etc.)
2. A separate official Time Log must be maintained for each Pinto and rider/driver participant enrolled in the program.
3. All time figured is on a one Pinto-one rider/driver basis and is on the honor system.
4. Actual time spent riding or driving shall be kept in full and one-half hour increments (i.e. 2.5 hours)
5. Double hours may be earned while riding or driving in national and state parks, grasslands or historic areas as recognized by the U.S. or Canadian National Parks Service or riding on Official PtHA Trail Rides.
6. Participants are responsible for submitting official On The Trail Time Logs to the association in order to earn recognition or awards. Participants should keep copies of all official Time Logs sent to PtHA.

Submitting Time Logs

You will receive a welcome letter and your first official Time Log sheet when you enroll in the On The Trail program. Once a Pinto/rider combination is inactive for three years, the record is deactivated and enrollment fees and hours forfeited. For additional Time Logs or to enroll another Pinto or person, you may download the forms from www.pinto.org or by calling (405) 491-0111.

Award Levels

Recognition levels are: 100; 500; 1,000; 1,500; 2,000; 3,000; 4,000; 5,000; 6,000; 7,500 and 10,000 hours.
