

# INDIAN ROCK ACRES SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

The purpose of the Indian Rock Acres Sportsmanship Award is to recognize a youth member of the IPtHA for outstanding sportsmanship during the year. This annual award was originally sponsored by the Robert Howard family of Indian Rock Acres, Franklin, Indiana.

The intention of the family was that this award would promote year-round good sportsmanship, mannerly showmanship, and genuine friendships among all IPtHA members.

The rules are as follows:

1. The youth must be a current member of IPtHA.
2. A nominee must be 18 or under, not having reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by January 1 of the current year.
3. The youth must be nominated by a current member of IPtHA.
4. Send only one nomination per family.
- 5 A youth may win this award an unlimited number of times.
6. An individual award will be given to the winner each year.
7. In the event of a tie, a duplicate award will be given.
8. The winner will be selected by a vote of the committee.
9. A committee member may not vote if she or he has a child nominated for this award.
10. The award will be presented at the Year End Awards Banquet.
