Annette gave us an updated report from the National Pinto Convention which included some new and exciting programs. These programs will be discussed further to be possibly put in place at the next club meeting during the Rochester Show in May. Please go to our National Club's website to read minutes from those meetings. One of these will include a "Super Horse Award" which our members will be able to discuss and decide how our club would like to award it. The actual yearly certificate will come from the National Pinto Office, so please be thinking about your ideas for this award.

We also brought up in some detail the upcoming "Hoosier Classic Shootout," which we will officially kick off at the Rochester show. Any first and second place showmanship horse, either English or, Western horse, pony or mini will be eligible for the finals at the last show of the year in New Castle. Our youth program, run by Kim Ingle and Jill Duzan, is always looking for fun activities and ideas for classes to be held during our shows. We have decided to do a raffle at each show, including the East Central Pinto Jubilee and invite those other clubs involved to hold their own raffles, if they wish, for each club's youth program. There was much discussion about the newly established Solid Division, previously know as Breeding Stock. You may know of someone that has a solid horse that would love to join our club and have a nice place to show their horses. I invite you to express our

As it stands still no animal with any Appaloosa or Draft characteristics are allowed, however a gelding only of Appaloosa blood, displaying NO characteristics of this breed can be registered. Most of those outcross papers will have N on that registration paper. Questions; please refer to the new rule book or just contact the registry.

We are now offering the utility classes at the upcoming shows. I have been contacted by a group that have Gypsy Horses and they would like to establish a club for that breed and also join our group and attend the shows. I offered them a place to gather at the Hoosier Horse Fair around 2:00 on Sat. so if you happen to see them, please extend our welcome to the new folks.

2013 PtHA Annual Convention Report

The annual convention was held this March 6-9 2013 at the Wyndam Garden Hotel in Oklahoma City, OK. This was a very productive meeting and the Pinto Horse Association of America is standing on firm ground, even though here are several breed associations that are suffering during the current economy, and we should be very proud that our association is still showing some growth even thought is has been slow. The minutes will be published and I am not going to go over the formal breakdown of the meeting, but I do want to point out some of the more important highlights of our meetings.

The Nominating Committee, chaired by Joe Grissom recommended Kathleen Gallagher the New Hampshire Director for the 3rd committee member on the Executive Board. She was voted in as the new committee member.

Suzanne Crews, CPA and our Treasurer Dorothy Fread reported on the Financial state of our association and presented the directors with the proposed budgets for 2013, any member who would like to see those I have them and you are welcome to see them. One of the highlights of the report was that due to the payoff of our building loan in March of 2011, it has made it much easier for us to survive the current economy. We saw a slight increase in both registration and transfers and a slight drop in the number of memberships. Our world show last year showed an increase with nearly 1,100 horses, 2,100 exhibitors and 6,800 class entries. That is a true counting and not inflated as some associations do by counting the number by each division and then adding them usually increasing the actual number by as much as three times.

Matt Stockman reported on Marketing/Media/International. He stated that we have picked up two new Corporate Sponsors who will be offering membership benefits. One is Priefert who will offer a 15% discount to member and Wrangler who will offer benefits to be announced. The Pinto Internationally is growing and a new website is being developed. There is a new email address for those international pinto enthusiast and it will be pintointernational@gmail.com.

Amanda Bradley is our new Website and Magazine contact at the PtHA office. She is changing our website and making it much easier to navigate and is putting in links that will let you jump around and access things in a much more user friendly fashion.

Registration/Transfers/Leases is now handled by Chasity Beasler. Due to recent back surgery that Matt has been going through the registration department is running a litter behind, but Matt is now back to work although moving somewhat slowly, the department is nearly back to its normal time frames.

Youth is also handled by Chasity Beasler, the more important youth annoucement is the moving of the Youth Conference to the World Show in June. It will make it easier for youth from all the states to participate. The date will be June 9, 2013 in Tulsa, OK.

Judges were reported on by Kim Hall, we had 21 applicants for Judges Approval and 12 were invited to participate in the CBC judges seminar. Nine attended and 8 made it through and will be listed as new judges available.

Heidi Slaughter is the go-to person at the office for Amateur and Performance Department. It was reported that in 2012 we held 615 total shows, 111 pinto and 504 OCAP shows.

In 2013, the Pinto Congress will host the Western Dressage World Show. This is an up and coming group and it gives another avenue to show your very handy and capable western horses. Information is available through the National Office on this organization.

New Fees: 2015 fees for a regular member will go up to \$50 and for youth \$20. A lot of members are taking advantage of the new Lifetime member scale. After the age of 39 the cost drops dramatically. In 2014 Registration fees will change, weanlings will stay the same, yearlings go to \$70, 2 and over goes to \$90 and Field Rep will go to \$100. In 2014, the judges application fee will go up to \$100.

The Directors were asked to give Darryl Bilke permission to change the Animal Welfare verbage and bring it in line with AQHA. It is becoming quite an issue with the Animal Rights Group and it protects our shows when these groups show up looking for issues. If we have our rules posted and someone comes policing these issues, we can head off any problems.

Two by-laws and Constitution changes were voted on, there will be listed on the website in the minutes, I have them if anyone wants to see them ahead of time.

We have changed our terminology for Breeding Stock horses, that division is now called Solid Horse. There are the hoses we now accept into our registry that are of accepted outcross breeds that show no pinto characteristics. There was an issue at the office of a hose that was registered with the ABHA that was solid and a gelding and they wanted to be registered in our solid division so they could show. It had Appaloosa parentage, but showed no signs. When the Appaloosa Association found out we were considering letting the Geldings (only with the N on their registry) they wanted us to collect a \$200 "Performance Fee" from these horses and make it payable to them, as they charge these horses this fee to show. We said, no thanks.

In 2014, a Super Horse Program is being initiated. This is a program that the National Office will furnish certificates to horses that earn this stature by whatever criteria the charters set up.. it is up to us to come up with our own rules for the horse that wins. It is just an award that they will issue to us if we decide to implement the program.

Also in 2014, each paid member will receive a \$10 coupon they can use at a show toward fees. It is non-transferable and can be used much the same as we do our show bucks. We send them in to the national office and it is deducted from our show expenses.

An Official Guide and Handbook was handed our for a code of conduct for those that represent National Office in any way, from Youth Directors to Field Reps and Executive Committees.

There will be no question as to your responsibility and conduct.

I attended two Committee Meeting, the Marketing/Membership Committee which I am a member on, was chaired by John Kile. Ann Cummings of Connecticut proposed a special reduced rate membership for grandparents, this will be some type of program that will give recognition to all the grandparents who are out there footing the bills, hauling the kids and spending time sitting in the bleachers and getting no reward for their effort. There will be a special Grandparents Day and hopefully a reception at the World Show to honor them. So if you have any ideas, come forward, as this is in the works for 2014.

I also attended the Registration Committee, as I am not on that committee, I could not participate but I wanted to attend as there were going to be some decisions made concerning the acceptance of Appaloosa bred horses. This was a very spirited meeting. It was recommended by the committee, accepted by the Executive Board that solid non-characteristic Appaloosa bred horses that are GELDINGS only may be registered in the Solid Division. These horses MUST have an N on their papers which indicated that the horses show NO qualifying characteristics of any kind. Their applies to geldings only, mares and stallions that could be used for breeding will not be considered under any circumstances into the solid division registry group.

It was suggested that we might consider a height breakdown for the Pony Division. This will be A: 38-46", B: 45-52": and C: 52-56". It is understood that at most shows these will be combined to make point classes as entries will not be large enough. We are seeing a growth in the pony division that makes this a natural way to divide them, and if the small ponies feel they might not have to show against the larger ones they may be more willing to show. It was merely a suggestion but could come up as a rule change proposal.

Out of all the rule change proposals put before the committees, only three made it and passed before the Board of Directors. I am not going to list them in their entirety here as you can go online and see them. Basically, they were allowing halter exhibitors to attach their number in the front on their hip. This allows trainers, etc. that are showing several animals to easily make the number change. Making is mandatory that exhibitor numbers be visible on each side of the bike. The 3rd was concerning year end points becoming official 60 days after the posting of the show on E-Pinto or Jan 7th, whichever comes first. After that no changes can be made.

Overall, I think we have a great time, Woodie and Leathe Marshall of Kentucky respected judge and friend of Indiana Pinto was inducted into the Wall of Fame. We had a reception for them after the ceremony and they were greatly appreciative.

Why I choose to show with Indiana Pinto

Does anyone else have the feeling of being totally overwhelmed during show season? The feeling of not knowing what you are doing, whether your horse will act the same way it does during practice come show day, or just simply did I practice enough? Will I forget something important, like horse feed or my girth to my saddle (which I've done)? I have been back into showing for a little over three years now and I still get panicky the night before because of one or all of these questions.

Having these questions now is nothing compared to my first year back showing. I will admit freely to anyone that I'm green when it comes to many, many things about horses and especially showing. I just wanted to do some trail riding when I bought my mare in 2009 from our fearless leader of Indiana Pinto, Cheryl Walls. I didn't think I would stand a chance in the show ring, but she told me I should come show with her in Indiana. "It'll be fun!" she said. I had shown my horse in high school 4H, so why not, it was fun then why wouldn't it be the same now.

Time came for the show and here I was with a horse who had a lot of trust issues that wouldn't manifest just how bad they were until the buzz and excitement of the show hit us. I had no idea about body shaving. I'd only ever shown in the summer, surely I didn't have to shave my entire horse! So the night before the spring show Cheryl taught me how to shave my horse, which resulted in her getting kicked and having to show all weekend with a goose egg sized lump on her ankle. My mare is also part Arabian and considered Pleasure type, which means different clothes and a different stance while in the ring. I had only ever showed my quarter horse, how was I know? How was anyone to remember all these new rules? I was never going to get the hang of this!

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Vet's Corner

Why Vaccinate??

The appropriate selection and timing of vaccinations for your horse are important factors in an equine health maintenance routine. AAEP (the American Association of Equine Practitioners) sets guidelines for equine vaccines based on a variety of factors including:

- Risk of exposure
 - Disease concerns are dependent upon which area of the U.S. a horse resides. Eastern, Western, and West Nile encephalitis are all carried by mosquitoes which, in Indiana's often temperate climate, can be present nearly any time of year. Disease exposure also varies from farm to farm. Horses in barns that have many horses coming and going throughout the year will have increased risk of exposure to contagious diseases, such as Strangles and Equine influenza, as will horses that travel to shows and sales. Farms with wet areas such as ponds, marshes, and low areas where water collects give horses increased exposure to Potomac Horse Fever, which is transmitted by a small snail.
- Consequences of the disease and vaccine effectiveness
 - Veterinarians and horse owners must take into account the affects of a disease and effectiveness of vaccines when choosing what to vaccinate for. For instance, tetanus is a deadly disease that is difficult and costly to treat when a horse is affected, but the vaccine can easily prevent the disease and save the owner the cost of treating and risk of losing their horse. Eastern, Western, and West Nile encephalitis are also very efficient at preventing their respective diseases. Rabies, a disease that has long been studied and vaccinated against, is the single most dependable vaccine on the market. There is no way to treat a horse once they have been exposed to rabies and it is highly transmissible to people once a horse is infected. The only way to effectively prevent the disease is to vaccinate. The vaccine for Potomac horse fever is not completely preventative but if a vaccinated horse contracts the disease, it will have much less severe symptoms than an infected horse that is unvaccinated. At Conley and Koontz we can discuss your individual vaccine program based on your horse's needs and risk of exposure.

One of the most difficult things to understand about vaccines is that they are not 100% guaranteed to prevent disease. There are a multitude of factors that contribute to a horse contracting a disease, including stable environment, insect exposure, the physiologic status of the horse, and the horse's individual immune system. However, vaccination is very inexpensive when compared to the cost of treating a horse after contraction of a disease that could have been prevented with a vaccine. At Conley & Koontz, the pharmaceutical companies that manufacture our vaccines guarantee protection for Eastern, Western, and West Nile encephalitis, as well as Equine Influenza and Tetanus. If your horse has been appropriately vaccinated **by your veterinarian** according to the vaccine recommendations and contracts one of the above diseases, the manufacturer will pay to treat the disease.

There are several principles of vaccination that are important to follow carefully in order to confer adequate protection for your horse.

• A primary series of vaccines must be administered at the appropriate times prior to possible disease exposure. If you have a horse that has not been vaccinated before, or if you are unsure of the vaccine history, it is important to give a booster one month after the initial vaccination.

Without a booster, the vaccination is not as effective and your horse will not develop adequate protection against the disease. Also, if you are traveling to a horse show, sale, or other venue, it is ideal to have your horse vaccinated at least 3 weeks prior to travel. This will allow adequate time to mount a protective immune response. Vaccinating too close to the event will not allow your horse to be protecting against the disease if exposure occurs.

- All horses in a herd should be vaccinated at regular intervals according to the attending veterinarian. Vaccinating only certain horses could allow unvaccinated horses to contract a disease and spread it to other horses in the facility.
- Pregnant mares should be vaccinated according to the schedule of your veterinarian. Vaccination for rhinopneumonitis should be given at 3, 5, 7, and 9 months of gestation to prevent abortion due to equine herpes virus. Rotavirus vaccine should be given at 7 and 9 months of gestation, and prior to foaling to aid in preventing rotavirus infection in foals after birth. Prior to foaling, the mare should also be boostered with all her annual vaccinations including Eastern and Western encephalitis viruses, West Nile virus, tetanus, influenza, rhinopneumonitis, strangles, Potomac Horse Fever, and rabies. This will confer immunity to the foal and aid in protecting against disease until the foal is vaccinated at 5 months of age.
- Vaccines should be administered by a licensed veterinarian to ensure that they are appropriately given with minimal risk of side effects. If side effects occur, the presence of a veterinarian will allow treatment to be administered if needed.
- Vaccines should only be purchased from a licensed veterinarian. Those sold at commercial stores do not carry a vaccine guarantee and handling/storage of the vaccines may not be reliable and could decrease the effectiveness of the vaccination.

AAEP's core vaccines, for which ALL horses should be vaccinated, include:

- Tetanus
- Eastern Equine Encephalitis
- Western Equine Encephalitis
- West Nile Virus
- Rabies

At Conley & Koontz Equine Hospital, we regularly vaccinate against the following diseases based on the needs of the individual horse.

- Equine Influenza
- Equine Herpes Virus (rhinopneumonitis)
- Potomac Horse Fever
- Strangles

These diseases are prevalent in the equine population in Indiana and can either be prevented or have decreased severity of signs with vaccination, so are very important to include in your preventative health program.



- 1. IPtHA will handle the pre-entries for the 2013 East Central Pinto Jubilee Show. (Use ECPJ Forms)
- 2. Checks are deposited after the show weekend.
- 3. Entries with missing information and paperwork may not be registered at the Pre-registration reduced fee.
- 4. PtHA requires Master Entry Forms to be filled out completely. If there are 2 or 3 places on the form that require the same information, you must fill it out in every place. If you own the horse, your name and address will be on the form twice.
- 5. Pre-Registration must be postmarked **10 DAYS PRIOR** to the date of the show.
- 6. All handwriting must be clear, recommend printing. We will not "decode" words or numbers. If we cannot read the form, **NO REDUCED FEE.**
- 7. Conditional Registrations will be accepted until your national paperwork is received. Once you receive your Registration Papers or Membership Cards, you are to send a copy for the IPtHA records.
- 8. On master entry form, list only AM classes in AM section, only YA classes in YA section and only Open classes in the Open section.
- 9. Horses registered in multiple names require a current Joint PtHA Membership Card and each exhibitor must have a current Individual PtHA membership.
- 10. PtHA Rules require you to present a current PtHA Membership Card or purchase one prior to showing. Pre-registering makes everything run smoother, as well as saves you money. 2013 IPtHA High Point Rules

- 1. You must be a current 2013 member of IPtHA at the time of nomination, no later than August 3, 2013. Points will count after nomination is received and dues are paid. Under no circumstances will points be made retroactive.
- 2. Horse and/or Pony/Miniatures must be registered in the Pinto Horse Association. All leased horses and/or pony/mini must have a copy of the lease on file with the High Point Chairman. The person leasing the horse/pony/mini must be an IPtHA member.
- 3. Only IPtHA approved shows will count toward IPtHA High Point Awards. IPtHA approval must come from the IPtHA President.

The shows approved for 2013 are: Spring Show at Rochester, May 18-19 (4 judges), EC Jubilee Show at New Castle, August 3-4, (3 judges, not average card) and Fall Hoosier Classic show at New Castle, September 7-8 (4 judges).

- 4. Ties for awards will be broken by the horse/pony/mini or rider/driver with the most firsts, then seconds, then thirds, etc., then most classes shown.

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
