


What is a Pinto?

The difference between a Pinto and a Paint horse is that the Pinto horse can be from an array of many bloodlines and The Pinto Horse Association of America recognizes 54 horse, pony and miniature outcross breeds. The American Paint Horse is limited to registered bloodlines of Paint, American Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred horses only.

What is the Pinto Horse Association of America?

The Pinto Horse Society started in the 1930s with the purpose of breeding superior colored horses. The current Pinto Horse Association of American was incorporated in 1956 and includes more than 12,000 members and 140,000 horses, ponies and miniatures.

There are 11 different types of membership in PtHA. Membership entitles members to the annual PtHA Rule Book, special member rates for most association services, the online Pinto Horse Magazine (published 7 times per year), quarterly newletters, monthly email newletters and access to E-Pinto.

<u>PtHA recognizes 5 sizes of Pintos</u> – Horse (more than 56 inches or 14 hands), Pony (38-56 inches), Miniature B (34-38 inches) and Miniature A (34 inches or less). A Pinto Utility Horse is an equine possessing Gypsy or Drum breeding, regardless of height.

<u>PtHA classifies the Pinto into five distinct types:</u> Stock, Hunter, Pleasure and Saddle types. The two Utility types include Gypsy and Drum.

In order to register a horse as a Pinto, the horse must have 4 square inches of cumulative white in the qualifying zone and underlying pink skin (3 square inches for ponies and 2 square inches for miniatures). Any Pinto that is registered with an approved outcross breed and has documented color on the outcross papers is eligible for registration. The equines that do not meet the color requirement, but have at least two or more Pinto characteristics (blue eyes; leg white above knee or hock; white or multi-colored hooves; collective white in the eligible zones, but not enough to qualify for color; pink skin) are registered in the Solid Registry. Pintos are classified as having either Tobiano or Overo color patterns.

How to register your Pinto

Pinto horses can be registered directly through The Pinto Horse Association of America or through a PtHA Field Representative. To register a Pinto directly through PtHA, visit their website at www.Pinto.org to download all membership and registration application forms. PtHA Field Representatives can be found at most PtHA horse shows and can inspect your horse, fill out theCopy necessary paperwork and assign a temporary PtHA number that allows you to show immediately and is good for three months. The Field Representative will then forward the paperwork to PtHA and a permanent number will be assigned. Please see the PtHA website for complete information on registration requirements including color, approved outcross breeds, sizes, etc.

Paperwork needed for PtHA Horse Shows

- 1. Copy of current National PtHA Membership Card for Owner and Exhibitor, if applicable. Also, a copy of current Amateur and/or Youth National PtHA Membership Card(s), if applicable. (All Memberships can be obtained at the show.)
- 2. Copy of current National PtHA Registration Paper for the horse, pony, mini or utility to be shown. (On-site PtHA Registration is available at all Indiana PtHA Horse Shows for qualified horses.)
- 3. Copy of all applicable paperwork including PtHA Lease Notification Form, Family Relationship Form, etc. SEE THE SHOW BILL OR OUR WEBSITE FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION.
- 4. Copy of current negative Coggins Test. PLEASE NOTE: The State of Indiana requires all out-of-state horses to have a current Health Certificate please bring a copy of this as well.

Any of the above items not provided to the Show Office may result in disqualification. The required copies listed above will be retained in a file by the Show Office staff for the current show season.



2014 PtHA Annual Convention

The annual convention was held march 6-9, 2014 at the Wyndam Garden Hotel in Oklahoma City, OK. This year's meeting was small due to weather conditions throughout the US, but a quorum was met and the meeting was opened with the Board of Directors Meeting on Thursday morning at 8am. Minutes and financial reports are posted up on the website.

After roll call by Kim Hall, there was a call to order by our president Gary Streator. He all seated our new directors and alternates. Kim Hall from the PtHA office read the removal of directors who did not attend the required number of meetings and were dropped from the board. Our PtHA rules require the automatic removal of directors who have missed three consecutive meetings.

Chairman Joe Grissom of the Nominating Committee reported that after conducting the executive board interviews that Woody Marshall from Kentucky be nominated to serve as the third committee member on the executive board. Two directors interviewed from the position. Karen Craighead from Missouri was nominated from the floor. Karen won the vote. Unfortunately, it was determined later during the convention that an alternate had voted and alternates only serve on the board if their director cannot be present. Our attorney said that the vote was not legal and needed to be held again. Woody then declined the nomination rather than have any problems and hard feeling cause on the executive board, he received a standing ovation. It was unfortunate as he was the choice of the nominating committee.

Mahlon Bauman read the bylaw change for the last and final reading. When approved this bylaw change will go into effect in 2015. Bylaws page 11, Article VI, section 2.G. The National PtHA President will appoint a director in a qualifying state, or a replacement director for the unexpired term of any director that no longer qualifies as a director from a particular state or international area, for whatever reason, including but not limited to: death of director, change of residence outside of state or international area, non-renewal of membership, resignation, etc. Subject to approval of the PtHA executive committee.

Confidentiality forms were passed out and required by all board of directors to sign. With Facebook and other internet media outlets, it has been determined that some of our directors could pass on information that PtHA considers confidential and not for public discourse. We signed, agreeing not to pass on confidential information discussed during board meetings. These sites have been monitored, you will get a letter and will be dropped from our pinto site if they feel you have overstepped and used inappropriate conduct for the PtHA site. It was strongly recommended that our members be careful of how they conduct themselves on any social media site and it is a direct reflection on the Pinto Horse Association.

The PtHA office staff was introduced and give a few minutes to talk about their positions. The biggest loss to the staff was Matt Stockman, who left to take a position with the Tulsa Chamber of Commerce, he will be sorely missed. New to the staff is Alannah Castro, who is taking over the Youth/Amateur and International Departments. Wyneta Duncan is the Youth Committee Chairman and will work closely with Alannah. She had some good ideas and hopefully you will see some fun things in the future. She wants to try to get the State Youth Director program working better and have more participation. This application must be turned in to the office by May 1st. Any one interested in being a youth director must apply to the state director. I have applications for anyone that is interested. It is strongly recommended that our Youth Director attend the 2014 World Show Championship and that their term will from form the 2014 World Championship to the 2015 World Championship. A meeting will be held at the World Show with an election of National Officers. Anyone interested in the position, please contact me.

Amanda Bailey reported on the magazine, e-newsletter and Facebook. The Pinto Facebook had over 5,000 fans.

World Show programs are being sent out and we will have them at Hoosier Horse Fair.

Noteworthy information given during reports is as follows:

A promo video is going to be made about what makes a pinto unique. This will be made available to clubs to use at horse fairs and other organizations to help promote the pinto horse

The photo contest that was held this past year had a record number of entries and a great selection of photographs.

The judges committee reported that we had 8 judge applications, 7 were approved to attend the judges seminar. Six attended with 4 passing to become pinto judges. We have a very tough system to pass through and become a judge and we require our judges to attend seminars to retain their judge cards.

We held 116 approved pinto horse shows. 2300 horses competed with over 5300 entries. There were 495 OCAP shows approved. 485 horses competed at the OCAP shows, 165 horses participated in the On The Trail program. In the Zone Rivalry, we had 10 Amateur teams and 4 Youth teams. The World Show had 1050 horses, 2300 exhibitors and they competed in 7800 entries.

The Colorbreed Congress had 485 horses, 325 were pinto, 68 palominos, 40 buckskin, and 25 appaloosa.

The Western Dressage Association is one of the fastest growing areas of the horse industry. Their 1st world show was held in conjunction with our Congress show in November. There were 365 exhibitors. The Colorbreed Congress gave a \$1000 scholarship to high point exhibitors in each color breed division.

Fred Kinder from the IT department stated that they have upgraded the internet with ATT state of the art fiver optics.

Gerry Milburn reported on the Heritage Foundation which Bobbieanne serves on the board. They are now giving 10 scholarships each year. They have 180,000+ in assets.

It was great that we had some of our Indiana members to attend the awards banquet and had the opportunity to visit the National Office. Those of you who have never been to the office don't realize what a treasure this place is. The entire office is like visiting a museum. It is really nice to see what an impact people from Indiana has had in the development of our association. I highly recommend that if you are ever in OK City, you take the time to stop and see your pinto home.

The Long Range planning committee made up of our past presidents and chaired by Joe Grissom met at the convention and they reported on many long range plans.

- 1. Overlapping show approvals cause by stated that do not have good show facilities using those from another nearby state.
- 2. Awards for the OCAP program. This is an area that is growing and we need to encourage those that do not show at the breed shows to show in the OCAP program. Right now all they get is a certificate.
- 3. Membership renewals. Right now people do not renew until they get ready to show at their 1st show, so they are discussing fiving some incentives to get an early renewal.
- 4. They discussed the problem of directors who do not attend the meetings and have to be dropped from the roles. A proposal of holding more conference calls with the directors to keep us more involved.
- 5. They discussed a possible Gist Buckle give to the Three Top Charters. There will be an application and the selection will be made in October for super charters. These will need to be charter that run their shows correctly, getting all their paperwork in on time without mistakes. I think we should apply, since we have Joe!!

We were encouraged to use our corporate sponsors more. They usually have good deals for charters if we contact them. We have tried to use Tioga for our Jubilee Show.

There are some field reps who are not getting their information in on time. It was reported that they will follow the rules and those missing the 15 day time frame will be dropped from the field rep

program. They are still have problems with shows that do not get their show results in on time and they are incomplete. They are considering starting a show managers program and requiring show managers to attend seminars every 2-3 years. Setting up webinars so show managers will not have to travel to the convention, but have to pass a questionnaire to be approved.

Daryl Bilke discussed the Western Dressage Association, we have been working very closely with them and as they are a new association he would like to offer to develop a program with them. Do an awards program for them and do their computer work. We are offering an extra day of dressage at our world show. This is a very growing association and we would be in on the ground floor.

Several have pushed to have a Horse Sale at the world show. It is something that most on the executive board do not want to get involved with. The track record for these sales has not been worth the effort. It was discussed about doing a 5000 series, and then people who see them show or being worked on the ground will know that they are for sale. They can take the number to the office and we will give them the information they need to contact the seller. The association would make \$100 and would be uninvolved from that point, we just need to hook up the buyer with the seller, and the rest is up to them.

During the committee meeting the various committees met with their chairman and cochairman. Only one had any rule changes to be discussed and that was the show/contest committee. They defeated the proposed changes in committees. The breed council met to go over any rule changes that were to come before the board of directors. The rules that were brought before the board of directors was a proposed guideline for handicapped riders program, it passed. An Amateurs Masters Certificate. This is proposed to recognize amateurs over 55 taking an active role in their association by not only showing but taking an active role in their club on a volunteer basis. They propose that all the guildelines stay the same but rather than a certificate, that it become a hall of fame award to be voted on by the past presidents and presented at the convention. The proposal passed.

Novice program, the amateur committee proposed that PtHA recognize the novice division same as they do the regular divisions. The novice amateur, and novice youth would receive certificates in the horse of year program same as regular divisions. They would still remain non ROM division. This also passed, these two new proposals will be effective beginning 2014.

Zone Rivalry, it was proposed that the "zone" restrictions be take away so that teams could be formed across zone lines. All other requirements would stay the same as for number of members on the team, etc. this will be called Team Rivalry. It passe and will take affect in 2015.

The convention concluded with the awards banquet. This year was particularly nice because we had a great group of Indiana members come to pick up their awards. It was nice to have Jim and Alex Yagel, Toni Trumbower, Jill Duzan, and Krissy Fairfield attend the awards banquet.








My Experience with Pinto



A Tribute to a Good Friend! By: Alex Yagel



Learning at 40: By Deb Hilbert



Vet's Corner

Lameness:

Misdiagnosis Leads to Owner Frustration

As veterinarians we are often asked to evaluate horses for chronic lameness. An owner may want an initial lameness exam or be seeking a second opinion on a previously diagnosed problem that has not resolved. Too often we see horses that have been "diagnosed" with "Navicular Disease" without ever undergoing a complete diagnostic work up. The owner may grow frustrated with the diagnosis when the lameness hasn't improved or resolved. Navicular disease or syndrome is not a radiographic diagnosis, it requires multiple diagnostic tools and clinical evaluations. This case report is an example of a horse that presented for previous radiographically diagnosed "Navicular Disease" and what we found on our complete clinical examination.

Case Presentation: "Ranger" a 7 year old American Quarter Horse gelding presented to Conley and Koontz Equine Hospital for a second opinion. The horse had a lameness in the right front which their original veterinarian attributed to caudal heel pain or navicular disease. Based on the original veterinarian's diagnosis, the owner had been treating for navicular disease with no improvements. Physical Examination: On presentation the horse had a grade 2/5 lameness in the right front limb. There was no apparent swelling or physical abnormalities.

Diagnostics: Due to the history of lameness and no improvements, the owner had become discouraged and asked us to start over with the lameness examination. Hooftesters were applied to the hoof with no apparent abnormalities. A wedge and reverse wedge test were performed with very little change. The horse was lunged shortly in the round pen with some worsening of the lameness when the right front foot was on the outside. Nerve blocks to localize the lameness were performed. A palmar digital nerve block, which blocks the heel region, navicular bone, and the sole, was performed with very little improvement. Moderate improvement was achieved with a pastern ring block. Because of incomplete resolution of the lameness, an abaxial sesamoid block was performed. The lameness resolved completely with this block. Based on the localization of the lameness with perineural anesthesia, radiographs and ultrasonic examination of the pastern region were performed.

Radiographs: The referring veterinarians radiographs were reevaluated and found to have a small cystic structure along the flexor surface of the navicular bone. Standard radiographs were taken to evaluate

the distal limb. There were no additional bony abnormalities on plain radiographs. In light of the nerve blocks it was determined that the navicular changes were not significant and suspected to be incidental.

Ultrasound: Ultrasonic evaluation was performed on the soft tissue structures of the palmar pastern region. Based on perineural anesthesia, the ultrasound examination was focused on the lower fetlock joint to the level of the heel bulbs. Upon examining the sesamoidean ligaments, a small defect was discovered within the sesamodean ligament

Plan: Various treatment options were discussed with the owner. The treatment options included:

- 1. Stall rest: Based on the chronic nature of the lameness, we did not feel this was a viable option, but it was offered to the owner.
- 2. Stall rest with shockwave therapy: Shockwave therapy has proven to be a very beneficial treatment option in the management of lameness in the horse. Click link to read more about <u>shockwave therapy</u>.
- 3. Regenerative Therapies: In the last couple years, regenerative therapy has become the mainstay of therapy for soft tissue injuries. There are various options which are commercially available, but we routinely recommend either platelet rich plasma or stem cell therapy. It is our opinion at Conley and Koontz Equine Hospital that regenerative therapies coupled with shockwave therapy give us the best chance for resolution of lameness. Click link to learn more about regenerative therapies.

Treatment Plan: Based on the chronic history of lameness and the owners desire to proceed with the greatest likelihood of recovery, we decided to treat Ranger with shockwave and stem cells.

An intense treatment schedule was made and therapy began promptly. It was recommended that shockwave therapy be performed every two weeks for three courses of therapy. At the first shockwave appointment adipose tissue was collected and sent for culture.

The horse was placed on stall rest with minimal hand-walking while we were performing the shockwave therapy. The stem cells arrived after approximately 3 weeks after adipose collection. Because of the size of the lesion it was decided to perform an intravenous regional perfusion to administer the stem cells. The horse was discharged to return in two weeks for a final shockwave therapy. After the final shockwave therapy, the horse was discharged to home with instructions of minimal hand-walking and a recheck after a total of 90 days.

Follow-up: At 90 days post treatment, Ranger returned for a follow-up examination. An ultrasound

examination was performed and the lesion was found to be resolved. A lameness examination was performed and he was found to be sound at the trot. The trainer and owner were instructed to give the horse an additional 30 days of restricted controlled exercise, but they could gradually increase the amount of exercise he was receiving.

Discussion: Perineural anesthesia or nerve blocks are the mainstay of a thorough lameness examination. Too often, they are performed inappropriately or skipped altogether. Sadly, this can result in a misdiagnosis. Proper application of nerve blocks as well as timing to observation afterwards allows for an accurate diagnosis. Too often, the horse is allowed to sit for an extended period of time allowing the local anesthetic to diffuse cranially leading to a misdiagnosis.

In Ranger's case, the initial diagnosis was made on radiographs alone. In other cases we have reevaluated, we suspected the palmar digital nerve block was performed too far up the limb or the horse was allowed to stand for an extended period of time allowing the local anesthetic to diffuse up the limb and the area of injury. When performing an intensive lameness exam at Conley and Koontz Equine Hospital we are focused on just one horse and therefore can dedicate our full attention to the horse and the outcome of the nerve blocks.

Shockwave therapy has been used for treatment of soft tissue injuries and pain for over 10 years. It has been shown to help the quality of healing, but not necessarily the time to resolution. In this case we used shockwave for two reasons. The first was to help with the quality of healing. The second was due to the chronicity of the lesion, we used shockwave to help attract the stem cells to the area of the injury. In chronic cases there is a concern that chemical and physical mediators which attract and regulate stem cells are no longer present. The use of the shockwave therapy would help to create a low degree of inflammation and help attract the stem cells administered through intravenous regional perfusion.

Regenerative Therapies are becoming more and more popular for treatment of soft tissue injuries. Platelet rich plasma and stem cell therapies are available from various commercial companies and we offer both in our hospital. Because of the success of stem cell therapy, we frequently recommend this over platelet rich plasma, but there is a cost difference between the two therapies.

Too frequently as veterinarians we are presented with lame performance horses which have been misdiagnosed and mismanaged. Too many times we are faced with horses that have been given the easy diagnosis and told to rest or have had multiple joints injected hoping that this helps resolve the lameness. By the time a horses receives multiple joint injections, they have been given a systemic dose of steroids and of course they would feel better, but we have not got to the root of the cause. With the improvements in technology such as digital radiography and digital ultrasonography, we are able to image and diagnose previously difficult lameness cases.

In this case, we used three standard nerve blocks and digital ultrasonography to make a relatively simple diagnosis. With the combination of shockwave and stem cell therapy we were able to make an aggressive therapeutic plan and successfully return Ranger, within a few months, to the level of competition he was at prior to his injury.

2014 IPtHA High Point Rules

- 1. You must be a current 2014 member of IPtHA at the time of nomination, no later than August 2, 2014. Points will count after nomination is received and dues are paid. Under no circumstances will points be made retroactive.
- 2. Horse and/or Pony/Miniatures must be registered in the Pinto Horse Association. All leased horses and/or pony/mini must have a copy of the lease on file with the High Point Chairman. The person leasing the horse/pony/mini must be an IPtHA member.
- 3. Only IPtHA approved shows will count toward IPtHA High Point Awards. IPtHA approval must come from the IPtHA President.

The shows approved for 2014 are: Spring Show at Rochester, May 17-18 (4 judges), EC Jubilee Show at New Castle, August 2-3, (3 judges, not average card) and Fall Hoosier Classic show at New Castle, September 6-7 (4 judges).

- 4. Ties for awards will be broken by the horse/pony/mini or rider/driver with the most firsts, then seconds, then thirds, etc., then most classes shown.
- 5. You must show under at least 7 different judges from the above IPtHA show list to qualify for an IPtHA Year End Award.
- 6. Walk/Trot and Lead Line classes will award points to the rider only. Children/Adults riding in these classes cannot show in any canter classes or the points in these classes will not count.
- 7. Transferred horse will retain all accrued points to date of sale. Points do not transfer to the new owner.
- 8. Any horse changing types will lose all previously acquired points. Altered stallions will retain their type halter points.
- 9. NO extra points for Grand or Reserve Champion winners will be awarded.

- 2. Checks are deposited after the show weekend.
- 3. Entries with missing information and paperwork may not be registered at the Pre-registration reduced fee.
- 4. PtHA requires Master Entry Forms to be filled out completely. If there are 2 or 3 places on the form that require the same information, you must fill it out in every place. If you own the horse, your name and address will be on the form twice.
- 5. Pre-Registration must be postmarked **10 DAYS PRIOR** to the date of the show.
- 6. All handwriting must be clear, recommend printing. We will not "decode" words or numbers. If we cannot read the form, **NO REDUCED FEE.**
- 7. Conditional Registrations will be accepted until your national paperwork is received. Once you receive your Registration Papers or Membership Cards, you are to send a copy for the IPtHA records.
- 8. On master entry form, list only AM classes in AM section, only YA classes in YA section and only Open classes in the Open section.
- 9. Horses registered in multiple names require a current Joint PtHA Membership Card and each exhibitor must have a current Individual PtHA membership.
- **10.** PtHA Rules require you to present a current PtHA Membership Card or purchase one prior to showing. Pre-registering makes everything run smoother, as well as saves you money. The checks sent In with the Pre-registration will be deposited after the show. **Read each area carefully**, and make sure everything is filled out properly. The intention of the family was that this award would promote year round good sportsmanship, mannerly showmanship, and genuine friendships among all IPtHA members.


The rules are as follows:
